Sport holds a significant place in the vibrant atmosphere of Rovinj, where locals and visitors alike embrace various professional and recreational activities.

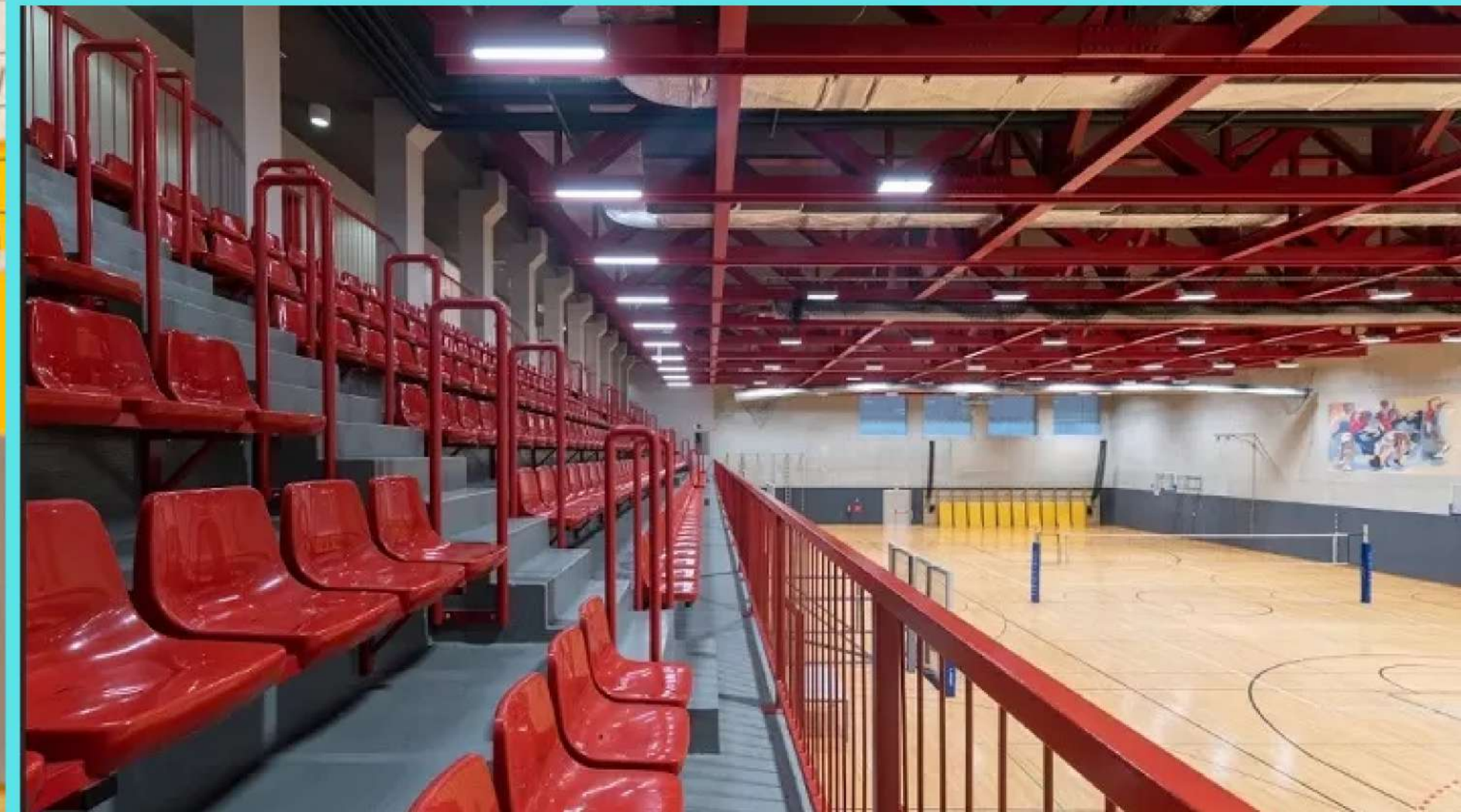




VALBRUNA SPORTS HALL

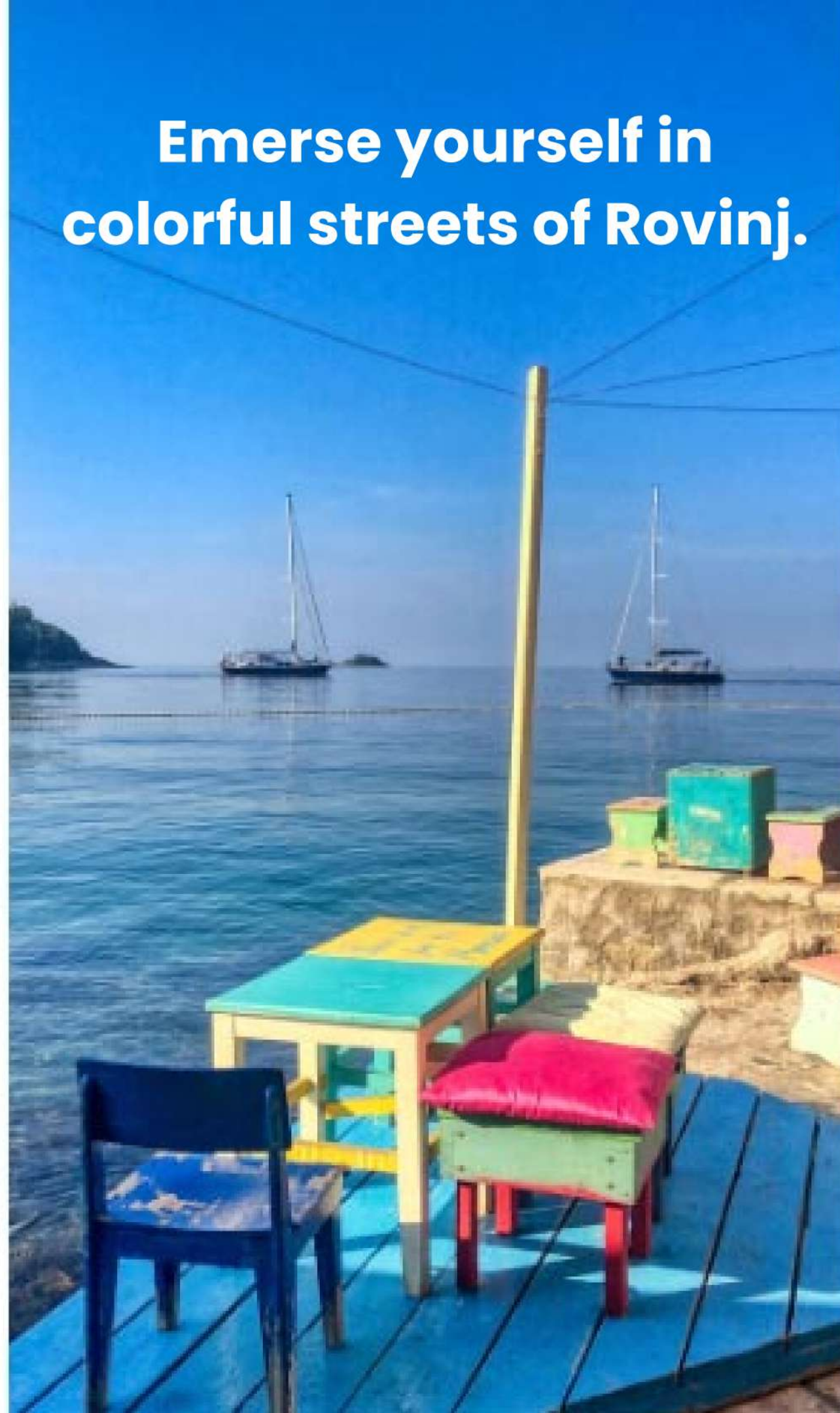
SIGHTSEEING
